The Charles W. Lamden School of Accountancy (School) at San Diego State University (SDSU) invites applications for an assistant professor, tenure-track position beginning Fall 2018. This position is contingent upon state funding. Applicants should have completed a Ph.D. or DBA in accounting or business administration before August 2018. We are seeking applicants with a demonstrated research agenda, strong commitment to excellence in teaching, and professional accounting experience (professional certification is desirable).

The School expects applicants to:

- Perform high quality academic research in the areas of managerial or financial accounting.
- Engage in teaching excellence at the undergraduate and/or graduate levels.
- Participate in service to SDSU and the accounting profession, including interacting effectively with the business community.

San Diego State University (SDSU), founded in 1897, is the largest and oldest higher education institution in San Diego and among the oldest in California. SDSU has been designated by the Carnegie Foundation as a "Research University with high research activity," and has been ranked the number one small (14 PhD programs or less) research university in the United States. The SDSU College of Business Administration is AACSB accredited with approximately 4,000 undergraduate business majors and over 500 graduate students. Its accomplished faculty and highly ranked academic programs provide an exceptional foundation for an institution with significant regional, national, and international impact.

SDSU is a large, diverse, urban university and Hispanic-Serving Institution with a commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusive excellence. The School's academic programs are a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (BSBA) – Accounting Major, Master of Science in Accountancy (MSA), and a combined 4+1 degree program (BMACC). The School's faculty includes 16 tenure-track faculty as well as several full- and part-time lecturers. Support for research includes access to databases (e.g., WRDS), funding for approved projects through grant programs, and graduate student research assistants.
