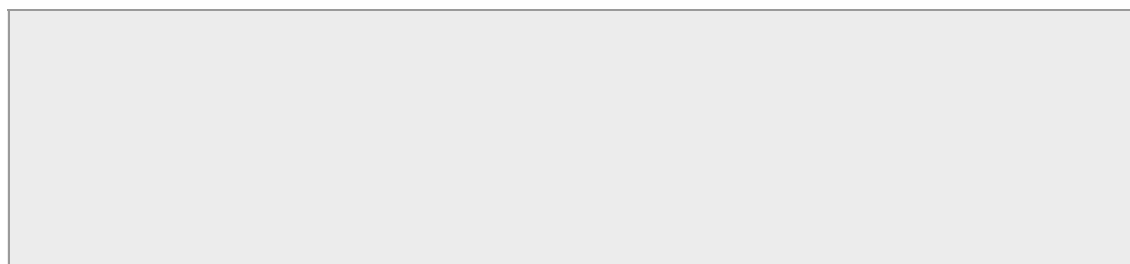
A Spring Review

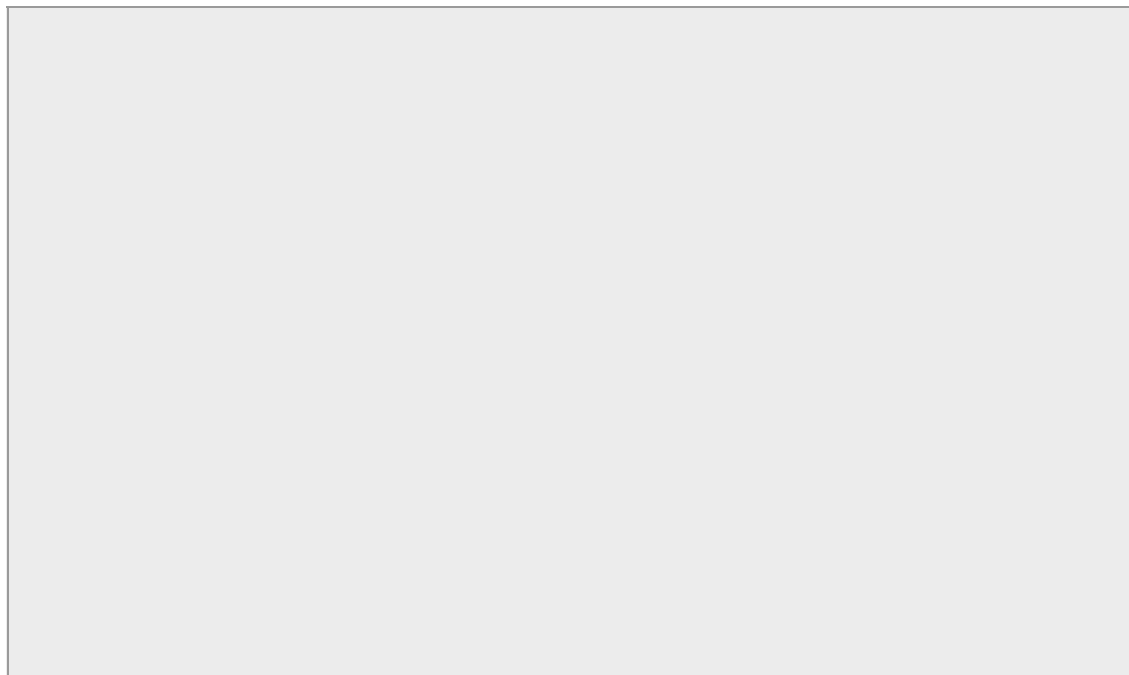
