Can Learn From Other Countries. Dr. Lea's testimony focused on his research comparing developed country housing finance systems and mortgage products. He joined four other academics for a wide-ranging 3 hour session with the committee. Much of the discussion focused on the future of Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac. Dr. Lea pointed out that no other major developed country has their equivalent and other systems achieve comparable levels of home ownership, housing quality and access to housing finance with much less government involvement than the US.
