Part-time or Full-time Based on Academic Schedule

- Working full-time or other full-time commitment
 - -> Part-time (1-6 units per semester)
 - 2 classes
- Working 20 hours or less
 - -> Full-time (9 units & + per semester)
 - 3 classes and over

 - 3. Career Track
 - 9 units
 - 4. Culminating Experience 3 units



What Classes Do I Take First?

Rule of Thumb: Start with Prerequisites (if needed), then Core Courses then Specializations/Electives. Your Culminating Experience should be taken in your last semester.
