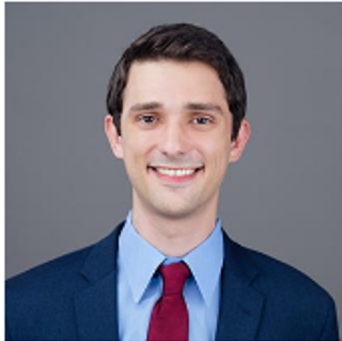

# Part-time or Full-time

## Based on Academic Schedule

- **Working full-time or other full-time commitment**
  - -> Part-time (1-6 units per semester)
  - 2 classes
- **Working 20 hours or less**
  - -> Full-time (9 units & + per semester)
  - 3 classes and over
- **It's all up to you!**
  - (But remember you need to maintain a 3.0!)

  - Need to complete 30 Units
- **Four Categories:**
  - **1. Prerequisites**
  - **2. Core Courses 18 units**
    - IS Technology- 9 units
    - IS Management and Analytics- 9 units
  - **3. Career Track**
    - 9 units
  - **4. Culminating Experience 3 units**



# What Classes Do I Take First?

**Rule of Thumb: Start with Prerequisites (if needed), then Core Courses then Specializations/Electives. Your Culminating Experience should be taken in your last semester.**
