BMACC Program Important Information and Instructions

APPLICATION DEADLINES: October 1st and March 1st*

*Note: If you anticipate completing your undergraduate coursework by May or August 2025, apply before January 21, 2025.

*Students planning to finish undergraduate coursework by December 2025 should apply during the spring 2025 application cycle, no later than March 1, 2025.

Please read the following information and instructions before completing this application to apply to the BMACC program. Before you apply for the BMACC program, please be advised that this program is unique. It is a combined BS/MS program and students must successfully complete 150 units to be awarded simultaneously, the B.S. degree in Business Administration, Accounting, and then the M.S. degree in Accountancy.

Students must apply and be admitted to the BS/MS (4+1) program (BMACC). Once you apply and are admitted into the program you must fulfill all requirements of the BMACC program before you will be granted the BS or the MS degree. If you change your mind and decide to go back to the Accounting major BS degree, you will **not be able to re-enter the BMACC program** and the graduate units you completed will **not count towards a graduate degree** at SDSU.

Note on Commencement: BMACC students participate in commencement exercises ONCE, at the completion of their master's degree. At that time, students are given the option to join BOTH the undergraduate and graduate ceremonies. BMACC students do **not** participate in commencement upon completion of their bachelor's degree requirements.

Requirements to Apply for the BMACC Program

Students may apply for the BMACC program at any time during their undergraduate studies after completing a minimum "B+" grade in ACCTG 331 (**or** completing at least two core courses, defined by ACCTG 331 and one of the following ACCTG 332, ACCTG 333, ACCTG 334, ACCTG 431, ACCTG 432).

It is recommended that students apply for BMACC during their second semester of upper division if eligible.

- 2. 3.0 SDSU GPA
- 3. 3.0 Overall GPA

MSA Scholarship for BMACC Students

All applicants MUST check the "Yes" box to be considered for any BMACC/MSA scholarships. Failure to check the box will make you ineligible for any BMACC/MSA scholarships. All eligible scholarship applicants must comply with all requirements and requests for information within the stipulated timelines.
